(If not show them)</li> <li>Are you suffering from flu-like symptoms?</li> <li>Have you been on this farm before?</li> <li>What will you be doing on farm?</li> <li>Where do you want to go on the farm?</li> <li>If doing work on farm, what risks will you be taking to get the job done?</li> <li>What 'controls' will you use to reduce risks?</li> <li>Have they beenyou had sufficent training to do the work ? (do you have the appropriate licenses and training)</li> <li>What are your contact details? Do you have an estimated time you will be on site?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>What the farm's normal operations are and what's happening during their visit</li> <li>What the key hazards are on site. Show them the farm map and highlight the current risks to their safety on farm to/from and in work area</li> <li>Show them the farm's 'No-Go Zones' on the map</li> <li>Tell them the farm's contact details and who's in charge during their visit if the manager isn't there</li> <li>Tell them where there are Kids on Farm they must look out for</li> <li>Tell them the farm's emergency procedures and back-up plan if no phone coverage</li> <li>Ask them to report:</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Stop, think, and then do the task safely</li> <li>Wear personal protective equipment (PPE) and choose the right equipment for the task</li> <li>Choose the right vehicle for the task, conditions and skill level</li> <li>Speak up when we see unsafe behaviour and hazards</li> </ul>
After you have briefed Contractors/Visitors, get them to sign farm staff they are on farm		<ul> <li>Please review the safety notice board each time you visit</li> <li>Do not enter any areas unless authorised to do so</li> <li>Speed limit onsite is 30kms per hr</li> <li>Always wear a seat belt while driving on farm</li> <li>Wear your Hiviz in designated areas so we can see you</li> <li>Watch out for our kids on farms</li> </ul>
